

PATH TO LIFE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION
FOR BAHAMAS ACADEMY OF SEVENTH DAY ADVENTISTS

This scholarship provides opportunity for a student to attend Bahamas Academy from Grades 1-12. The scholarship is academic and need-based, and will cover 80 % tuition as funds are available. **This scholarship is given in honor of Pastor Neville and Alwhyne Scavella outstanding leaders in the Bahamas.**

Applicants may be Adventist or non-Adventists and from public or private schools. The Scholarship Committee will interview short-listed candidates before the final selection is made.

The selected student will be required to maintain a G.P.A. of 2:5 or higher during the scholarship period and is also expected to remain in good standing while matriculating at Bahamas Academy of Seventh Day Adventists. Access to academic and leadership mentorship and coaching will be provided for the scholarship recipient. As previously indicated, the tuition will be funded up to eighty percent of each quarters school fees while the parent and or guardian will be responsible for twenty percent. Books and uniforms are not included.
